### Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)

#### 3

### Club Standard of Dress (CSOD) and Placement of Cam, Patches, Service Ribbons and Badges

1. The required Dress Code for all members is:
  - a. When attending a General Meeting or other official Club event or Club run:
    - (1) Club Vest;
    - (2) Trousers - Blue, Black or Cams;
    - (3) Closed leather footwear.
  - b. Ceremonial (Parades/Marches/Funerals)
    - (1) Club Vest with medals;
    - (2) Trousers - Blue or Black;
    - (3) Camouflage trousers are not to be worn.
    - (4) Closed leather footwear.
2. The following items of dress are not to be worn with a Club vest:
  - a. Shorts, thongs, sandals or similar types of footwear unless a medical condition recommends otherwise and the Executive have been advised;
  - b. When riding a motorcycle, members are not to wear shorts, thongs, sandals or similar types of footwear.
3. Whilst in a motorcar your vest must not be worn.

#### All Patches to Be Sewn Not Glued

4. Any patch (fabric or plastic) attached to our vest is to be sewn not glued.

#### Mis-Treatment of Club Colours

5. The mis-treatment of Club colours is a grave offence and is to be viewed by all members as disrespectful to

the Club and its members.

6. It is, first, a privilege to wear Club colours, voted upon by the majority of Service Members, thereby allowing any member to wear the breast plate and number plate. Second, any disrespect to our colours will be viewed as a sign of resignation. Removing your colours or disfiguring your colours, or 'throwing down your colours' will be viewed as your decision to leave the Club; hence not wishing to wear our colours.

7. As such, any occurrence at disrespecting your colours, regardless of your personal opinion and/or personal mind-set, will trigger the Nat Exec in enforcing its decision to terminate your membership in the Club. There is no appeal.

8. All members are to refer to Fig 1,2,3 and 4 for guidance on proper placement and wearing of Club regalia on their vests.
