Regardless of the Sub Branch or any external issue to their Sub Branch, every member of a Sub Branch should be made aware of any issue in the Club, as any issue within a Sub Branch is also an issue with the Club in general.
Result
<p>Members of a Sub Branch Executive took it upon themselves to make decisions for their Sub Branch members -without advising them nor giving them a plausible explanation based on clear facts. As a result, the Service Members in that Sub Branch could not exercise their right to vote on the issue.</p> <p>The Sub Branch Executive made decisions – on their own recognisance - which took the Sub Branch away from the direction that the Club was heading, being away from the Club Constitution.</p>
