<b>Situation</b>
A member questioned his management by his Sub Branch, while the Sub Branch did not take advice from the National Executive (NAT EXEC).
<b>Reference</b>
Our Constitution, in that <u>you join the Club and not a Sub Branch</u> : Constitution, Section 24 and Section 46 etc Constitution, Section 88 onwards Constitution, Section 105
<b>Result</b>
The member was advised that when joining the Club, it was a Club Application, not a Sub Branch Application, and the Constitution states that every member of the Club, belongs to the MBMMC Club, and not just a Sub Branch. If the member is in a Sub Branch, then the Sub Branch looks after him/her, for ADMIN purposes, and paying their Sub Branch Building Fund to that Sub Branch.  But he/she is first and foremost, a member of the Club (MBMMC), hence no Sub Branch can ever expel a Service Member without due process to the NATIONAL EXECUTIVE.
